### Nada New York features porcelain hot dogs and commanding chat bots

Sales come second to experiences at this art fair, and the crowd of artists, curators and scenesters seem to like it that way

For slightly more conventional tastes, the fair's main aisles offered works by emerging names that appealed to collectors' eyes and budgets. The Birmingham, Michigan gallery Reyes Projects, founded last year by Marlborough Contemporary alumna Terese Reyes, sold three paintings by the Detroit-based artist James Benjamin Franklin for \$8,000, \$3,500, and \$2,200, respectively. Franklin, who completed his MFA at Michigan's Cranbrook Academy of Art in 2017, is among a large group of Cranbrook grads choosing to stay put in the Detroit area post-graduation, adding to the buzz around the city's nascent art scene.
